- **I am one of the funders of The Norwegian Society for Clinical Sexology (NSCS). I have been president in NSCS for two periods (1985-1988 and 1999-2003), and President of the Nordic Association for Clinical Sexology (NACS) for two periods (1986-1988 and 2001-**

2003).

- I have been engaged in sexological education, and presented the Nordic Sexological Curriculum at the NACS-conference in Reykjavik in 1995. I was then member of the group who developed criteria and procedure for NACS authorization in sexology. I have been leader of this group until now, and I will resign at the NACS-conference in Tallin this autumn.
- Since 2001 I have been responsible for further education in sexological counseling, a 60 ECTS program, part time, at the University of Agder. The work has started to develop this program into a master in sexology. The profile of this master will be sexological counseling, with emphasis on clinical research.
- I am member of a research group, and one of the initiators of this group, who is part of a research review done by The Norwegian Knowledge Center for the Health Sciences. The report is due within a few months (!), and will be about the effect of treatment of sexual problems.
- Just now I am reviewing the treatment methods in common sexual problems in the material from The Knowledge Center, about 90 randomized and controlled studies on treatment effect.
- I have been part of the Euro-Sexo study, led by Alain Giami, and I was coordinating the Norwegian study in 2001.
- I am also a guest editor for Sexologies on an issue on sexological treatment.

Make a short statement on why you want to belong to the EFS executive committee:

It is important to develop the sexological field further, and international work is important in order to give sexology status and authority enough to bring further important tasks like education, practical work; in the clinics that has to be developed; in research, that needs to be encouraged and developed; and in sexual health promotion through different organizations, political fora and NGO's. My main interest is clinical work, and I believe it to be important to encourage research, and to develop clinical settings to be able to do the work as good as possible.

Sexology is an interesting field in order to challenge old paradigms, like the dichotomization of mind and body. Sexology has a tradition of integration, and I believe that we have important contributions to offer to the rest of the health care system.

I think I am a good team-worker, I am usually able to talk and work with different kinds of people. Through my clinical experience, I have developed competence in dealing with different perspectives and be creative in seeing solutions that take care of, if not all, so at least many interest.
