If you are already a member of the executive committee, please outline your contribution to the Federation during your term of office:

**Advocacy:** I have worked strenuously and successfully by securing an invitation to sit as a medical representative from EFS on the Regional Advisory Panel and on the regional committee annual meeting of WHO EURO (2009 was the first year EFS has ever been represented).

**Financial:** I have secured considerable financial amounts for EFS from negotiating and securing contracts with both a PCO and the publisher of our journal. This is the first time this has been achieved by any Treasurer of the Federation. The monies have allowed EFS to undertake work previously impossible due to low funding. In 2009, this included a strategic weekend and training event; meetings with WHO and the first joint meeting with another regional group FLASSES.

I have produced transparent and clear annual financial reports.

In Brighton 2004 I was congress president of the EFS congress and attracted 881 delegates. This was the largest number ever recorded for an EFS meeting and the event secured over GBP5,000 profit.

In 2006 I was the lead officer as General Secretary and Treasurer in securing a payment to EFS of €20,000 from the PCO in Prague. Thereafter, I recruited a world leading CEO and with the officers organized and together explored and recruited a PCO which secured incomes of €30,000 in 2008 and €40,000 in 2010 to allow the Federation to undertake work previously impossible due to low income entirely related to association fees.

In 2010 I have again been the primary officer to identify and negotiate with a number of interested PCO prior to recommending the PCO for 2012 & 2014. This includes an offer of €50,000 for a future event if we are successful with increased delegates and if not, still €40,000 – an offer which is better than that from our existing PCO at the time of writing.

**I have worked with our editors to secure income from our journal – with incomes for the first time in 2009 and greater income secured for 2010 and beyond.**

**I developed the EFS logo and website with the team during my early time in the position. This was in advance of the WAS logo which is synchronous.**

**Advances in Eastern Europe: With the president on two occasions and twice alone, I have visited Eastern European sexologists to identify & recruit new members and societies including Budapest, Bucharest, Moscow and Kiev with two further meetings scheduled with monies made available from the existing PCO contract.**

**In addition and following from my work 2002-2006 I have:**

- **established a secure membership base with more societies paying than ever before and have maintained regular contact throughout the last eight years**
- **Designed and maintained the web site with support from Dan Wylie**
- **Established one international bank account**
- **Created and made possible credit card payments on line**
- **Increased our finance income substantially**
- **Organised an EFS and FLASSES symposium in Florence at the WPA meeting in 2009 with Antonio Palha & Chiara Simonelli and two colleagues**
- **Maintained a substantial discount for all EFS society members to *Sexual & Relationship Therapy***
- **Been a strong advocate and tutor for the development of an European Diploma in Sexual Medicine with ESSM and the European Diploma**
- **Assisted in the scientific programme planning for the last 4 EFS meetings**
